Example # 2

Thesis: Although Pope's test scores indicate a population of skilled, high-achieving teens, there are many who are achieving at the peril of their happiness and mental health.

Chunk 1: High achievement at Pope

Topic Sentence for chunk 1: Pope students consistently achieve at high levels both in the classroom and on standardized tests.

- High SAT / ACT scores
- High Milestones scores
- Many students with very high GPA's
- High participation/ pass rate in AP classes

Chunk 2: Cost in mental health and happiness

Topic Sentence for chunk 2: While the achievements of Pope students are noteworthy, the pressures associated with this are taking a serious toll on students' mental and emotional well-being.

- Rise in anxiety / stress
- · Inability to participate in several activities due to workload
- Conflict with parents over grades
- Pressures of competing for college acceptance
